1. Masks are no longer mandatory for staff or customers	Infection from COVID-19	Staff and customers have the choice as to whether they would like to wear masks upon entering and whilst moving around the club. Ensure that all staff and customers who are unwell do not enter the premises and return home.	Ensure all doors that can be opened are opened to allow better ventilation throughout the premises.
2. Rule of six is no longer in force	Risk of infection and reduced social distancing due to bigger groups.	Handwashing and sanitiser provided for all visitors and staff. Social distancing ticketing still in place to ensure people keep their distance where possible.	Try to alternate tables and boards to ensure better social distancing between parties.
3. Bar service and seating at the bar has resumed	Inadequate mitigation measures expose staff and customers to infection.	App and table service still instated to allow people to distance as well as stay at their own tables and not attend the bar. Less seating available at the bar to ensure social distancing between persons sat at the bar.	Purchasing new table stickers to ensure that it is clear to customers that the app is still available to use.
4. The NHS Track and Trace is no longer mandatory	Less control over contacting close contact of any positive cases.	NHS Track and Trace QR Code still available for those who wish to check into the venue. Sanitising stations and cleaning stations still available to ensure hygiene measures are still in place to lessen the risk of covid 19 infections within the premises.	We do have our own members log in system which means we are aware of which members have been in the club on which days.
